

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Load up the fan brush with a generous amount of paint.
2. Apply one generous coat all over the outside of the bowl, making sure to get paint into all the crevices. Allow the paint to dry.
3. Use a damp sponge to wipe off the excess paint. We want to leave the paint in the crevices and remove the paint from the raised area.
4. Wipe the dirty sponge over the top rim to leave a little hint of color.
5. Leave the inside of the bowl unpainted, it will be white and shiny after it's fired.

TIPS

- Rinse out the sponge frequently as you're wiping the bowl to keep the raised areas clean.
- Any colors can be used for this technique.
