



## INSTRUCTIONS

1. Water down Grasshopper with 50% water to 50% paint.
2. Use a liner brush to apply vines to the center section of the planter, with 2 coats of the watered-down Grasshopper paint, allowing the lines to overlap.
3. Create the leaves with a detail brush and 2 coats of watered-down Grasshopper paint.
4. Use a detail brush to apply little flowers among the vines with 2 coats of the desired paint.
5. Apply the center of the flower by dipping the handle of the detail brush into the paint, and tap it on the center of the flower.
6. Water down Pumpkin Pie with 50% water and 50% paint.
7. Paint the inside of the planter with 2 coats of the watered-down Pumpkin Pie using a fan brush.
8. Use a small brush to apply 2 coats of watered-down Pumpkin Pie to the rim of the planter.

## TIPS

- By watering the paint down, you'll achieve a more translucent, watercolor effect. Do not worry about 3 coats, we are not going for solid colors.
- If desired, use a pencil or water-based marker to sketch on the flowers.
